Description for Eastern School District, Zones 10 & 11

Zone No. 10

Commencing at the shore of Northumberland Strait at Canoe Cove and on the eastern boundary of Hugh MacLeans farm (taken from 1880 atlas), thence northwardly along Hugh MacLeans east boundary to the rear boundary of the farms fronting on the Canoe Cove Road and the Long Creek Road, thence in a northwardly direction to the rear of the late Malcolm MacNeill's farm (taken from 1880 atlas), thence following MacNeill's farm boundary to Long Creek and following Long Creek, crossing West River and northwardly along Clyde River to the Trans Canada Highway (Route No.1), thence eastwardly along the said highway to the Linnwood Road (Route No.265), thence northwardly along said road to the Kingston Road (Route No.235), thence westwardly along said road to the Bannockburn Road (Route No.247), thence northwardly along said road to the North Wiltshire Road (Route No.225), thence westwardly along said road to the Colville Road (Route No.9), thence northwardly along the said road to the Mapleque Road (Route No.2), thence continuing along the said road to where the North River crosses the Malpeque Road, thence northwardly following the North River, crossing the Crabbe Road (Route No.256), Rustico Road (Route No.7) to the Township Lot 33, thence northwardly along the Township Lot 33 to an westwardly extension of the Kintyre Road (Route No.250), thence eastwardly along said extension and the said Kintyre Road (Route No.250) and the Kilkenny Road (Route No.250) and an eastwardly extension of the said road to Township Lot 34, thence southwardly following Township Lot 34 to an eastwardly extension of the Horne Cross Road (Route No.220), thence westwardly along said extension and the said Horne Cross Road to the community limits of South Winsloe, thence southwardly along said limits to the Royalty Junction Road at the C.N.R. right-of-way, thence westwardly along said road to the Winsloe Road (Route No.223), thence southwardly along said road to the Malpeque Road (Route No.2), thence southwardly along said road and University Avenue to Hermitage Creek, thence westwardly along said creek to Ellens Creek, thence northwardly along said creek to the Trans Canada Highway (Route No.1), thence westwardly along said highway to North River, thence southwardly along said river to Hillsborough Bay, thence westwardly along said bay and the Northumberland Strait to the eastwardly boundary of Hugh MacLeans farm to the point of commencement.

Zone No. 11

The boundary line between the Eastern School District and the Western School Board and respective school zones shall be determined by referring to the following reference line: where the reference line follows the Bradford Road and River Road (Route No. 117), between the Trans Canada Highway and the Augustine Cove Road (Route No. 10), the boundary line shall follow the centre line of the Bradford Road and the River Road (Route No. 117); and for all other points on the reference line the boundary shall be 3/10 kilometre to the west of the reference line. Commencing at the south shore of New London Bay and the Gulf of St. Lawrence, thence eastwardly along the said gulf to the Covehead Bay, thence southwardly along the said bay to the Township Lot 34, thence southwardly along said Township Lot 34 to an eastwardly extension of the Kilkenny Road (Route No.250), thence westwardly along the said extension, the Kilkenny Road (Route No.250) and the Kintyre Road (Route No.250) and an extension westwardly to the Township Lot 24, thence southwardly along said Township Lot 34 to the North River, thence southwardly along the said river, crossing the Rustico Road (Route No.7), the Crabbe Road (Route No.256) to the Malpeque Road (Route No.2), thence westwardly along the said road to the Colville Road (Route No.9), thence southwardly along said road to the Wiltshire Road (Route No.225), thence eastwardly along said road to the Bannockburn Road (Route No.247), thence southwardly along said road to the Kingston Road (Route No.235), thence eastwardly along said road to the Linnwood Road, thence southwardly along the said road to the Trans Canada Highway (Route No.1), thence westwardly along said highway to the Clyde River, thence southwardly along said river to West River, crossing West River to Long Creek and following Long Creek southwardly to Malcolm MacNeills farm, (taken from 1880 atlas) thence southwestwardly along MacNeills farm to the rear boundary of farms fronting on the Long Creek Road and the Canoe Cove Road, thence eastwardly along said rear boundary to Hugh MacLeans farm (taken from 1880 atlas), thence southwardly to the Northumberland Strait, thence westwardly to the east boundary of John M Leard (taken from 1880 atlas) and Edward McFayden (taken from 1926), thence northwardly along the said line and to the Enman Road to Augustine Cove Road (Route No.10), thence westwardly along said road to the River Road (Route No.117), thence northwardly along said road to the Bradford Road, thence eastwardly along the said Bradford Road to the Trans Canada Highway (Route No.1), thence eastwardly along said highway to the Branch Road (Route No.232), thence eastwardly along the said road to County Line Road, thence southwardly along said road to the Balaklava Road (Route No.232), thence eastwardly along said road to the Inkerman Road (Route No.231), thence northwardly along the said road to the South Breadalbane Road, thence westwardly along said road to the North Breadalbane Road, thence eastwardly along said road to the Route No.231, thence northward along said route crossing the Malpeque Road (Route No.2) to the Millvale Road (Route No.231) and continuing northwardly and eastwardly along said road to the Trout River Road (Route No.239), thence northwardly along the said road to the North Road (Route No.240), thence eastwardly along said road to the New London Road (Route No.224), thence northwardly along said road to the Simpsons Mill Road, thence northwardly along said road to New London Bay and continuing northwardly to the Gulf of St. Lawrence to the point of commencement.

School Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. S-2-1

Part IV - School Boards

Trustee Qualifications

28. (1) Subject to subsection (2) and to section 29, a candidate for school trustee shall meet the following qualifications to run in a school board election:

- (a) the candidate shall be a Canadian citizen, eighteen years of age or more on election day; and
- (b) the candidate shall have been ordinarily resident in the school unit for at least six months prior to the date of the election.

(2) The following persons are not eligible to run as candidates in a school board election:

- (a) persons who are not qualified pursuant to subsection (1);
- (b) employees of any school board; and
- (c) employees of the Department who are considered by the Minister to have a potential conflict of interest.

29. A candidate for school trustee for a French school board shall meet one of the following additional qualifications:

- (a) the candidate must be a parent of a student who is receiving French first language instruction in the province;
- (b) the candidate must be eligible to have a child receive French first language instruction; or
- (c) the candidate would be eligible to have a child receive French first language instruction if the candidate had a child.

Elector Qualifications:

32. (1) Subject to subsection (2), Canadian citizens who are at least eighteen years of age on the date of the election and have been resident in the unit for at least six months are eligible to vote in a school board election for that unit.

(2) Voters in an election for a French school board must also meet one of the qualifications set out in section 29.

School Act Regulations

School Boards (EC 225/96)

Nominations

11. (1) Any ten or more persons, qualified under section 32 of the Act, may nominate a candidate for school trustee for the zone in which the nominator resides, by filing with the Zone Returning Officer, a nomination paper in a form approved by the Chief Electoral Officer, at any time between the beginning date of the election campaign (Monday, 28 April) and 4:00 p.m. on nomination day (Friday, 9th May).

(2) Nomination Day shall be Friday, the seventeenth day before ordinary polling day. (9th May 2008)
