Description for Eastern School District, Zones 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6

Zone No. 1

Commencing at a point on the Cable Head East Road (Route No.336) and the Gulf of St. Lawrence, thence southwardly along said road to the Kings Byway (Route No.16), thence westwardly along said road to the Ashton Road, thence southeastwardly along said road to the road leading to Five Houses, thence along said road to the St. Peters Road (Route No.2), thence northwardly along said road to the Forest Hill Road, thence southwardly along said road to the St. Peters River, thence following said river to Township Lot. 42, thence southwardly to Township Lot. 55, thence westwardly to the Clay Road (Route No.328), thence southwardly to the northern boundary of Township Lot. 54; thence in an eastwardly direction following an extension of the north boundary of Township Lot. 54 to Township Lot. 56, thence southwardly along said Township Lot 56 to Dundas Road (Route No.4), thence in a northeastwardly direction to Dingwall Mills, thence following the St. Peters Highway (Route No.2) eastwardly to the Bear River Road (Route No.307), thence by a line of extension southwardly to the Rollo Bay, thence eastwardly following the shore to East Point and then westwardly from East Point to the Cable Head East Road (Route No. 336) to the point of commencement.

Zone No. 2

Commencing at a point on the shore of Savage Harbour, thence southwardly along the said Harbour to the Kings/Queens County line, thence southwardly along the said county line to 48 Road (Route No.5), thence eastwardly along said road to Township Lot 52, thence southwardly along said Township Lot 52 to Cardigan River, thence eastwardly along said river to Cardigan Bay, thence eastwardly along said Bay, Howe Bay and Rollo Bay to an extension of the Bear River Road at Rollo Bay, thence by a line of extension northwardly from the Bear River Road (Route No.307) to the Souris Road (Route No.2), thence following Souris Road westwardly to Dingwells Mills and the Dundas Road (Route No.4), thence southwardly along said Dundas Road to the Township Lot 55, thence northwardly following the Township Lot 55 to a line of extension eastwardly from the Township Lot 51, 52, 53 and 54 line, thence following the said line to the east boundary of the Clay Road (Route No.328), thence northwardly along said road to Township Lot 41, thence eastwardly along said Township Lot 41 to Township Lot 42, thence northwardly along said Township Lot 42 to St. Peters River, thence northwestwardly following said St. Peters River to Forest Hill Road, thence northwardly along said road to St. Peters Road (Route No.2), thence southwardly along said road to the road leading from Five Houses to Ashton, thence northwardly along said road to the road leading from Ashton Road to Kings Byway (Route No.16), thence northwardly and eastwardly along said road and the Kings Byway (Route No.16) to the road leading to Cable Head East (Route No.336), thence northwardly along said road to the Gulf of St. Lawrence, thence westwardly along the said Gulf of St. Lawrence to Savage Harbour to the point of commencement.

Zone No. 3

Commencing at the county line between Kings and Queens County at the south boundary of the 48 Road (Route No.5), thence southwardly along said county line to Township Lot 59, thence eastwardly along said township line to Valleyfield River and Valleyfield Road (Route No. 326), thence eastwardly along said road to the Commercial Cross Road (Route No.4), thence southwardly along said road to the south boundary of Lower Montague Community Limits, thence eastwardly along the said community limits to the Campbell Road, thence northwardly along said road and an extension northwardly to the Montague River, thence eastwardly along said river to Cardigan Bay, thence northwardly and westwardly along Cardigan Bay and the Cardigan River to Township Lot 52, thence northwardly along said line to the 48 Road (Route No.5), thence westwardly along said road to the Kings/Queens County line to the point of commencement.

Zone No. 4

Commencing at the intersection of the Kings/Queens County line and the south boundary of Township Lot 66, thence southwardly along the said county line to Belle River Road (Route No.202), then westwardly along the said Belle River Road to the Murray Road, thence southwardly along the Murray Road and the Panting Shore Road to the Northumberland Strait, thence eastwardly along the said Northumberland Strait to Cardigan Bay, thence westwardly along the said Cardigan Bay to an extension northwardly from the Campbell Road, thence southwardly along the said extension and the Campbell Road to the north boundary of the Lower Montague Community Limits, thence westwardly along said community limits to the Commercial Road (Route No.4), thence northwardly along said road to the Valleyfield Road (Route No.326), thence westwardly along said road to the Valleyfield River and the south boundary of Township Lot 52, thence westwardly along said township lot line, Township Lots 51 and 66 to the Kings/Queens County line to the point of commencement.

Zone No. 5

Commencing at the point where the Hillsborough River intersects Fullertons Marsh, thence southwardly along said marsh to the Fort Augustus Road (Route No.21), thence southwardly along the said road and the Mt. Herbert Road to the Trans Canada Highway (Route No.1), thence continuing southwardly by a line of extension of the Mt. Herbert Road to Township Lot 49, thence eastwardly, northwardly and eastwardly along said township lot line to the Kings/Queens County line, thence southwardly following the county line to the Belle River Road (Route No.202), thence westwardly along said road to the Murray Road, thence southwardly along said road and the Panting Shore Road to the Northumberland Strait, thence westwardly along the Northumberland Strait, Orwell Bay, Hillsborough Bay and the Hillsborough River to Fullertons Marsh to the point of commencement.

Zone No. 6

Commencing on the Gulf of St. Lawrence and Covehead Bay, thence southwardly along the said Covehead Bay to Township Lot 34, thence continuing southwardly along the said Township Lot 34 and the extension thereof to an extension of Horne Cross Road (Route No. 220), thence westwardly along said extension and the said Horne Cross Road (Route No.220) to the eastern boundary of South Winsloe Community Limits, thence southwardly following the community limits to the Royalty Junction Road at the intersection of the C.N.R. right-of-way, thence westwardly following the Royalty Junction Road to the Winsloe Road (Route No.223), thence southwardly along said road to Malpeque Road (Route No.2), thence southwardly following the Malpeque Road (Route No.2) and University Avenue to Allan Street, thence eastwardly along said street to C. N. R. right-of-way, thence northwardly along said right-of way to Belvedere Avenue, thence eastwardly along said avenue to Mount Edward Road, then northwardly along said road to Pine Drive, thence eastwardly along said drive to Maple Avenue, thence northwardly along said avenue to Oak Drive, thence eastwardly along drive to the Brackley Point Road, thence northwardly along said road to the south boundary of the Charlottetown Airport, thence eastwardly along the said airport property to the Norwood Road, thence southwardly along the said road to the St. Peters Road, thence eastwardly along the said road to Andrews Pond on Wrights Creek, thence following Wrights Creek southwardly to the Hillsborough River, thence crossing the said Hillsborough River to the intersection of Fullertons Marsh, thence southwardly following the said marsh to the Fort Augustus Road (Route No.21), thence southwardly along the said road and the Mt. Herbert Road to the Trans Canada Highway (Route No.1), thence continuing southwardly by a line of extension of the Mt. Herbert Road to Township Lot 49, thence eastwardly, northwardly and eastwardly along said township lot line to the Kings/Queens County line, thence northwardly following the county line to Savage Harbour and following the Harbour to the Gulf of St. Lawrence, thence westwardly along the Gulf of St. Lawrence to Covehead Bay to the point of commencement.

School Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. S-2-1

Part IV - School Boards

Trustee Qualifications

28. (1) Subject to subsection (2) and to section 29, a candidate for school trustee shall meet the following qualifications to run in a school board election:

- (a) the candidate shall be a Canadian citizen, eighteen years of age or more on election day; and
- (b) the candidate shall have been ordinarily resident in the school unit for at least six months prior to the date of the election.

(2) The following persons are not eligible to run as candidates in a school board election:

- (a) persons who are not qualified pursuant to subsection (1);
- (b) employees of any school board; and
- (c) employees of the Department who are considered by the Minister to have a potential conflict of interest.

29. A candidate for school trustee for a French school board shall meet one of the following additional qualifications:

- (a) the candidate must be a parent of a student who is receiving French first language instruction in the province;
- (b) the candidate must be eligible to have a child receive French first language instruction; or
- (c) the candidate would be eligible to have a child receive French first language instruction if the candidate had a child.

Elector Qualifications:

32. (1) Subject to subsection (2), Canadian citizens who are at least eighteen years of age on the date of the election and have been resident in the unit for at least six months are eligible to vote in a school board election for that unit.

(2) Voters in an election for a French school board must also meet one of the qualifications set out in section 29.

School Act Regulations

School Boards (EC 225/96)

Nominations

11. (1) Any ten or more persons, qualified under section 32 of the Act, may nominate a candidate for school trustee for the zone in which the nominator resides, by filing with the Zone Returning Officer, a nomination paper in a form approved by the Chief Electoral Officer, at any time between the beginning date of the election campaign (Monday, 28th April) and 4:00 p.m. on nomination day (Friday, 9th May 2008).

(2) Nomination Day shall be Friday, the seventeenth day before ordinary polling day. (9th May 2008)
