Two Provincial By-Elections Announced **Charlottetown, PEI, Wednesday, July 16, 2025**

Elections PEI received the Executive Order today, Wednesday, July 16, 2025, from Lieutenant Governor in Council to issue the Writs of Election for two by-elections to take place on Monday, August 11, 2025.

Elections PEI CEO Tim Garrity explains, "*Eligible electors in district 9 and district 15 are heading back to the polls for this 2025 Provincial By-Election*". *Elections PEI has confirmed, Electors in these two districts will go to the polls on Monday, August 11, 2025, to vote for a new member to represent them in the Legislative Assembly of PEI*".

Advance Polls will take place Saturday, August 2, Monday, August 4 and Friday, August 8, 2025. Ordinary Polling Day Monday August 11, 2025. All voting will be open from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m. "All eligible electors in district 9 and district 15 should visit <u>www.electionspei.ca</u> for further details and all information associated with these by-elections," says Mr. Garrity. He further explains "the Returning Officers, their contact information and location is available now on our website. The Returning Offices will be open at 9 a.m. tomorrow to accept candidate nomination and registration papers. The deadline for candidate nominations is Friday, July 25, 2025, at 2 p.m."

The Office of the Returning Officer is open Monday through Friday 9 a.m.- 6 p.m., and Saturdays 10 a.m.-2 p.m.

All eligible electors in District 9 and District 15, registered with Elections PEI, will receive a Voter Information Card in the mail prior to the first Advance Voting Day, Saturday August 2, 2025.
