District 2: Georgetown–Pownal By-Election Announced

Elections PEI has received the Executive Order from the Lieutenant Governor in Council to issue the Writ of Election for a by-election in **District 2: Georgetown–Pownal**, scheduled for **Monday, December 8, 2025**.

Chief Electoral Officer Tim Garrity stated, “Eligible electors in District 2 will return to the polls for a by-election to fill the seat vacated following the resignation of Steven Myers on October 3, 2025.”

A new **interactive mapping tool** is now available on the Elections PEI website at www.electionspei.ca. By entering a civic address, electors can view their polling station details, voting times, and see who the registered candidates are, including how to contact their campaigns.

Advance Voting Days will take place on **Saturday, November 29, Monday, December 1, and Friday, December 5, 2025**, from **9 a.m. to 7 p.m.**

“All eligible electors in District 2 should visit www.electionspei.ca for complete election information,” said Mr. Garrity. “Contact information and office details for the District 2 Returning Officer are also available online.”

Due to the Remembrance Day holiday, the **District 2 Returning Office** will open at **9 a.m. on Wednesday, November 12, 2025**, to accept **candidate nomination and registration papers**. The **nomination deadline** is **Friday, November 21, 2025, at 2 p.m.**

Following Remembrance Day, the Returning Office will be open **Monday to Friday from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.**, and **Saturday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.**

All **registered electors** in District 2 should receive a **Voter Information Card (VIC)** in the mail prior to the first Advance Voting Day on **Saturday, November 29, 2025**.
