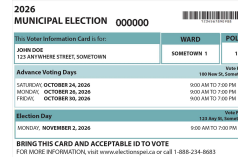


Identification is **REQUIRED** in order VOTE

Municipal Election Regulations Section 52 (2)



If you **DO NOT** have a **Voter Information Card**, follow one of the applicable steps below in order to receive your ballot to vote.

1) Show **ONE** of these pieces of ID (with current address)

- your PEI drivers licence
- your PEI Voluntary ID Card
- PEI Health Card with your name and current "**civic**" address



2) Show **TWO** pieces of ID to prove "who" you are and "where" you live

3) Oath of Elector

If your ID does not reflect your current residence, you **must** take the **Oath of Elector** (declaration)
