Prince Edward Island

Identification is **REQUIRED** in order VOTE.
(Election Act Section 65.1)

The quickest and easiest way to vote is to have your I.D. and Voter Information Card (VIC)



If you **DO NOT** have a **Voter Information Card**, follow one of the applicable steps below in order to receive your ballot to vote.

1) Show **ONE** of these pieces of ID (with current address)

- your PEI drivers licence
- your PEI Voluntary ID Card
- PEI Health Card with your name and current address



2) Show **TWO** pieces of ID to prove “who” you are and “where” you live

- Canadian Forces ID Card
- Canadian Passport
- Firearms Possession / Acquisition Licence
- Out of Province photo ID
- Hospital ID Bracelet
- Indian Status Card
- Hunting or Fishing Licence
- band Membership Card
- parole Card
- Student Card from Post Secondary Institute
- Veterans Affairs Health Card

Identification /Residence

- Voter Information Card
- Bank Statement
- Blank Cheque with Voter’s name imprinted
- Certificate of Title (vehicle/residence)
- Credit Card Statement
- First Nations Membership ID
- Gov’t Benefits Statement (EI, OAS, Social Assist. Disability Support, Child Tax Credit, Workers Comp, etc)
- Income Tax Assessment
- Insurance Policy/Certificate
- Letter from Trustee/Public Guardian
- Letter of Confirmation of Residence from First Nations Band
- Letter of Confirmation of Residence or documents of Admission or Statement of Benefits from:
 - long term care facility
 - senior’s residence
 - shelter /soup kitchen
 - student residence
- Pay Cheque / Stub (Gov’t or Employer)
- Residential Lease
- Utility Bill (power, water, cable)

3) Oath of Elector

If your ID does not reflect your current residence, you **must** take the **Oath of Elector** (declaration)
