
Dear Madam Speaker:

I have the honour to submit the Report of the Chief Electoral Officer pursuant to Section 122 of the Election Act, R.S.P.E.I. 1974, Cap. E-1 as amended by S.P.E.I. 1984, Cap. 19.

Writs of Election were issued on the 1st day of November 1985 with Polling Day on the 2nd day of December 1985 to fill the vacant Assemblyman seat in the Fourth Electoral District of Prince and the vacant Councillor seat in the Second Electoral District of Queens.

The only major problem encountered during the election period was in completing the enumeration and typing the lists of qualified electors. The present time frame does not allow sufficient time to complete the lists. Accordingly, I have submitted a legislative proposal to alleviate this problem.
