

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE****October 24, 2020 - Elections PEI busy at Advance Polls for D10 By-Election**

When the polls closed Saturday, October 24th at 7pm, Elections PEI saw a turnout of 15.42% of eligible registered voters casting their Advance Ballots in the District 10 By-Election, and an additional 5.64% voted by Mail In Ballot.
