RECOMMENDATIONS

Campaigning near the Polls

- 132. Every one is guilty of an offence, who, during the hours of polling on ordinary polling day
 - (a) supplies, carries or wears any flag, ribbon, emblem, badge or like favour with the intent to distinguish the user as the supporter of a candidate;
 - (b) supplies, carries or uses a loudspeaker, public address system, flag or banner with the intent that it be used to support a candidate;
 - (c) posts or displays in or within two hundred feet of a polling station or the building in which a polling station is situated, any literature, emblem, ribbon, flag, banner, card, bill, poster or device that supports a candidate; or
 - (d) organizes or participates in a parade or demonstration that supports a candidate.

Recommendation #1

- 1. The provisions of Section 132 should also apply to the three days of advance polling days.
- 2. Section 132 (a), (b) and (d) needs to specify where the provisions of this section are applicable. (i.e. within 60 metres of a polling location) Without any clarification, this section would be applicable anywhere within the municipality and challenging to enforce.
- 3. Section 132 (c) currently indicates two hundred feet and should reflect the metric equivalent (60 metres).

This only applies to the Town of Cornwall with the Open Ward system

Judicial Recount

- 91. At the time and place appointed and in the presence of the said persons, the judge shall proceed to make a final addition from the statements contained in the ballot boxes returned by the several deputy returning officers, and to count all the ballot papers, returned by the several deputy returning officers, and shall for that purpose open the sealed envelopes containing
 - (a) the used ballots (Form 114.Env.) which have been counted;
 - (b) the rejected ballot papers (Form 113.Env.);

With the recent Municipal Election in Cornwall, a judicial recount was requested by one of the candidates. The current wording of the bylaw required every ballot to be counted and therefore, every candidate listed on the ballot is gffected. With the recent election, there were eleven (11) candidates listed on the ballot as the Open Ward concept is utilized. The Judge was required to tabulate a count for each candidate on the ballot, regardless of the number of votes previously recorded. This resulted in the recount taking over twelve hours to complete.

Recommendation #2

Amend Section 91 to reflect parameters on the request for a judicial recount. This could include y cythe person requesting the recount must indicate which candidate they would like a recount against and should limit the number of candidates which can be indicated for the recount (i.e. candidate being requested to be included in the judicial recount must be within 15 or fewer votes).


