**Monday March 27, 2023**
*Second Advance Poll Busy for 2023 Provincial General Election*

The second Advance Poll in the 2023 Provincial General Election concluded at 7 p.m. on Monday, March 27, 2023. The polls were open from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m. with a voter turnout of 9,373 (8.89%) of 105,446 of registered voters or casting their ballots.

At approximately 10:30 a.m. there was a power interruption in Kings County with Maritime Electric and this affected polling locations in Districts 3 and 4. Elections PEI poll workers acted quickly and switched to battery backup to keep the advance vote continuing as scheduled resulting with little to no disruptions in voting, at those polls. Power was restored fully by 11:35 a.m.

There is one more Advance Polling Day, Friday March 31<sup>st</sup> from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m.

Ordinary Polling Day is on Monday, April 3<sup>rd</sup> from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m. Voters unsure of their voting location should check their Voters Information Card in the mail, or by visiting the Elections PEI website at [www.electionspei.ca](http://www.electionspei.ca) .
