

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE November 2, 2020 – District 10 Charlottetown – Winsloe By-Election

A By-Election was held November 2, 2020 in District Charlottetown – Winsloe as a result of MLA Robert Mitchell's resignations on September 6th, 2020.

Zack Bell of the PC Party is the unofficial winner of the By-Election, collecting 49.1% of the vote.

The Chief Electoral Officer of PEI Tim Garrity says, "Elections PEI is extremely pleased with the voting procedure with the District 10 By-Election", and adds, "We were facing many obstacles to ensure a safe vote for all electors in District 10 with a COVID-19 procedural plan in place." Garrity states, "voter turnout was 67% of the 4,311 eligible residents in District 10 casting their ballots in this by-election." Mr. Garrity thanks all election workers for doing a great job at the polls.

Elections PEI received a record number of Mail-in Ballot applications for a By-Election, as voting was to be very different in a COVID -19 environment. 240 Mail-in Ballot applications were processed, just under half of all mail-in ballots requests for the entire 2019 Provincial Election.
