Third Advance Poll for the 2024 District 19 By-Election

The third and final Advance Poll in the 2024 District 19 Borden-Kinkora By-Election concluded at 7 p.m. on Friday, February 2, 2024. Voting on the third day of advance voting was 450. To date, 1,126 or 26.81% of the 4,211 eligible and registered voters cast their ballots.

Electors who have received their Mail-In Ballots via courier must have their completed ballots returned to the Office of the Chief Electoral Officer by 12 p.m. (noon) on Monday, February 5, 2024 to have them included in the count.

Ordinary Polling Day is on Monday, February 5th, 2024 from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m. Voters unsure of their voting location should check their Voters Information Card in the mail, or by visiting the Elections PEI website at www.electionspei.ca.

For Ordinary Polling Day, CEO Tim Garrity explains *“in the event of inclement weather, I invite the electors in District 19 who haven’t voted yet to listen to local media Monday morning and check the Elections PEI social media and website, for further information in case the weather affects the vote on Monday”*.

Elections PEI will display the unofficial results of the 2024 District 19 By-Election on the Elections PEI website, Monday February 5th, following the ballot count which commences at 7:30 p.m.
