2023 Provincial General Election Announced
Charlottetown, PEI, Monday, March 6, 2023

Elections PEI received the Executive Order today, March 6th, 2023 from Lieutenant Governor in Council to issue the Writ of Election for a provincial general election to take place on Monday April 3, 2023.

Elections PEI CEO Tim Garrity explains, *“Eligible electors across Prince Edward Island are heading back to the polls for the 2023 Provincial General Election”. It has been confirmed, Islanders will go to the polls on Monday, April 3, 2023 to vote for their provincial government. For this election there are five registered political parties with candidates”.*

Elections PEI is hosting a new mapping feature on our website at www.electionspei.ca Simply, input your civic address, and details on your district’s polling locations and registered candidates will be displayed.

Advance Polls will take place Saturday, March 25, Monday, March 27 and Friday, March 31, 2023 from 9 a.m. until 7 p.m. *“All eligible electors on PEI should visit www.electionspei.ca for further details and all information associated with this provincial election,”* says Mr. Garrity. He further explains *“all Returning Officers, their contact information and location is available now on our website. The Returning Offices will be open at 9 a.m. tomorrow to accept candidate nomination and registration papers. The deadline for candidate nominations is Friday, March 17, 2023 at 2 p.m.”.*

The Office of the Returning Officer is open Monday through Friday 9 a.m.- 6 p.m., and Saturdays 10 a.m.-2 p.m.

All eligible electors registered with Elections PEI, will receive a Voter Information Card in the mail prior to the first Advance Voting day, Saturday March 25, 2023. Voter registration information may be updated on-line at www.electionspei.ca or by calling 1-888-234-8683.
